ZIRP Overview: 29 February 2020



Unconditional Cash Transfers

- 178,974 beneficiaries reached
- 212,004 people to receive assistance during peak lean season

Conditional Cash Transfers

- 30,301 beneficiaries reached
- 13 community assets rehabilitated



Restoring agricultural production

- 1,334 tonnes of agricultural inputs distributed
- 6,400 beneficiaries received agricultural inputs
- 5,914 beneficiaries trained on crop production

Restoring livestock production

- 805 tonnes stock feed procured & distributed
- 1,073 beneficiaries reached with stock feed
- 733 beneficiaries trained on stock feed utilization



Rehabilitating communal WASH services

- 7 suitable Civil Society Organizations identified to be able to provide immediate support in water and sanitation interventions in targeted communities.



Accelerating the revitalization of basic health service provision

- 816 people reached via health promotion interventions
- 33 village health workers trained on Integrated Disease Surveillance and Response (IDSR)
- 2,977 people received healthcare services in ZIRP target areas



Accelerating the revitalization of basic health service provision

- 162 village health workers completed training
- 80 village health workers are currently being trained
- 400 bicycles procured for village health workers



Rehabilitation of damaged community infrastructure

- 4 access roads currently under rehabilitation
- 1,830 farmers to benefit from rehabilitation of irrigation schemes
- 5 maternal health units to be constructed
- 100 community workers hired



Provision of learning and teaching supplies

- 273 units of school-in-a-box procured
- 70 classroom tents procured
- 250 recreational kits procured
- 47 Early Childhood Development (ECD) kits procured
- Distribution of teaching and learning kits to begin in March 2020



Technical assistance

- 4 camps assessed
- 198 households interviewed
- 909 people participated in the return intention survey
