ZIRP Overview September 2020

Livelihoods and Food Security

483,256 livestock have been vaccinated and treated. This includes cows, goat and sheep.

5,914 agricultural production and **1,073** stockfeed input beneficiaries trained on production

Design works for rehabilitation of **4** irrigation schemes completed

More than **230,000** people received food assistance to date

Health & WASH

25 outreach sites receive weekly services from ZIRP Mobile Health Team

307,152 people provided with basic package health services and support.

403 village health workers trained, covering 363 villages and 4 IDP camps

462 households have restored access to water and sanitation services

88 food distribution points reached with hygiene promotion campaigns

COVID-19

882,696 people reached with COVID-19 messaging

4,276 VHWs supplied with PPE and IPC

Education

19,076 students in 28 schools benefited from teaching and learning supplies

9,235 female students and **9,841** male students

15 classroom tents distributed

71 units of school-in-a-box distributed

15 Early Childhood Development (ECD) kits distributed

62 recreational kits distributed

Cross Cutting Elements

4 access roads undergoing rehabilitation

7 bilateral sensitisation meetings held on the integration of Gender Based Violence response under ZIRP

3 return assessment, reintegration and recovery surveys conducted in internally displaced person camps and villages.

88 food distribution points reached with community outreach including GBV awareness
